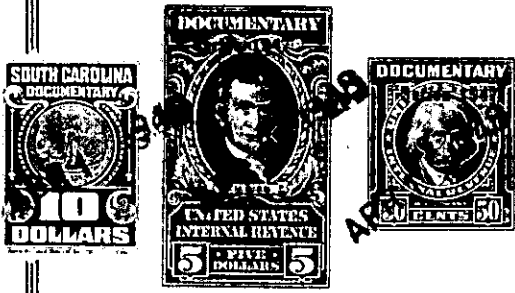

(\$5,000.00) Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the scaling of these presents  
by Ethel E. Harvey

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ethel E. Harvey, her heirs and Assigns  
forever:

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,  
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated  
as Lot No. 79 of Eastover, the same fronting sixty (60) feet on  
the South side of Beachwood Avenue as shown on plat recorded in  
Plat Book "F" at Page 42, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

This is the same property conveyed to me by deed of the  
Fidelity Federal Savings & Loan Association of Greenville, dated  
February 11, 1941, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County in Deed Book 230 at page 360.
