Greenville Township, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Saluda County, State of South Carolina, on both sides of the North fork of the Saluda River, containing two hundred and five (205) acres, more or less, and being bounded now or formerly by Martha Goodwin on the North, Anderson on the East, Robinson on the South and Poe and Rivers on the West. LESS, however, a tract containing one and 93/100 (1.93) acres conveyed by me to Virginia Jones Capps by my deed dated October 20th, 1947, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book No. 332, at page 127. This property is more fully outlined and delineated on a plat made by James K. Dickson, D.
