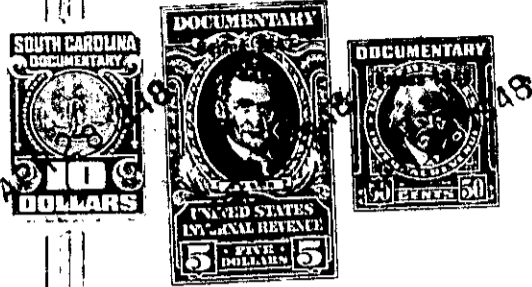

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, about ten miles South of the Greenville County Court  
House, near Conestee Mills, and more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stone on the Log Shoals Road, corner of lands now or formerly  
owned by S. J. Cox, and running thence N. 46 E. 19.00 chains to a stone; thence  
S. 83-1/4 E. 3.42 to a W. O.; thence S. 25-1/8 E. 15.28 to a stone; thence  
S. 58-1/2 W. 2.60 to a dogwood; thence S. 28 E. 4.42 to a stone; thence S. 20-1/2  
E. 10.08 to a dogwood on road; thence S. 34-3/4 W. 9.26 to an iron pin; corner  
of a ten-acre tract conveyed previously by A. M. Henderson to C. F. Riddle;  
thence along the line of said ten-acre tract, N. 50-30 W. 22.23 to an iron pin
