## THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT made and entered into this 20thday of February, A. D. 1948, by and between the CITY OF GREENVILLE, hereinafter spoken of as THE CITY, and the COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF GREENVILLE COUNTY, acting as the corporate authorities of GREENVILLE COUNTY, hereinafter spoken of as THE COUNTY BOARD, WITNESSETH:

## I. RECITATION OF FACTS

As a means of reflecting the true inducement to this contract, and the factual background incident thereto, IT IS AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO that the following facts and circumstances exist:

- (a). The County of Greenville has a population, according to the 1940 census, of 136,380. The present population of the County is estimated at 173,900. The figures above listed include the population of THE CITY. THE CITY itself has a population, according to the 1940 census, of 34,734. The present population of THE CITY is estimated at 46,000. The City of Greenville has an area of only 5.35 square miles. Its assessed valuation, according to the 1946 assessment, is \$11,496,050.00. The assessed valuation of Greenville County is \$34,542,375.00, which includes the assessed valuation of THE CITY.
- (b). The only public or general hospital in Greenville

  County is the hospital owned and operated by THE CITY. The

  County of Greenville neither owns nor operates a hospital, although

  it provides for the expense of its approved charity patients on

  a fixed per diem basis as a means of partially repaying THE CITY

  the cost of such patients served by the hospital who reside out
  side the corporate limits of THE CITY.
