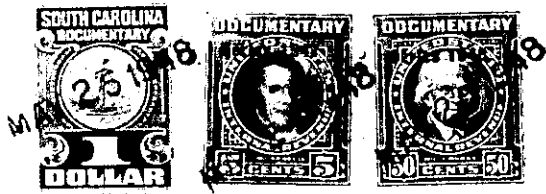

restrictions as set forth in an instrument recorded in Deed Book 291, pages 369 and
