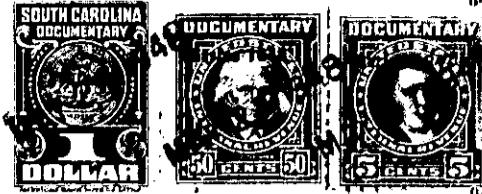

to me paid by James Green

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James Green, his heirs and assigns

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the limits of the City of Greenville, in what is known as Nicholstown, and being partly outside the city limits.

BEGINNING at the corner of two unnamed streets and running thence with one of said streets N. 20-45 E. 162 feet and 8 inches to an iron pin; thence N. 63-15 E. 87 feet and 3 inches to an iron pin; thence in a northerly direction approximately 180 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 62-45 W. 112 feet to the beginning corner, being known as Lots Nos. 6 and 7 on the revised plat of the land of Mrs. S. E. Serrine, made by J. E. Serrine Company, May 21, 1912 and adjoining lot of Perry Cooper. This being the same property conveyed to me on , or about, October 27, 1947.
