

All that certain lot of land near the City of Greenville, in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, known as Lot No. 5 on plat of Mrs. Melville Westervelt, et al. property made by Dalton & Neves, dated March, 1938, and recorded in Plat Book J, page 13, R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in Melville Avenue, joint corner of Lots No. 4 and 5, and running thence with said Avenue S. 17-47 W. 92 feet to corner of lot No. 6; thence with line of Lot No. 6, S. 59-38 E. 296.4 feet to iron pin, corner of Lot No. 6; thence N. 34-04 E. 20 feet to iron pin, corner of Lot No. 1; thence along line of Lots No. 1, 2, 3 and 4, N. 46-30 W. 327 feet to the point of beginning on Melville Avenue.

As to the southern line of said lot, see deed of Mrs. Melville Westervelt to A. K. Lewis, dated March 30, 1942 and recorded in Deed Book 243, page 336.

The above described lot is conveyed subject to the restrictions and conditions contained in the agreement between Mrs. Melville Westervelt and others, dated December 28, 1938 and January 5, 1939, and recorded in Deed Book 208, pages 86-87.
