

In general, to carry on any other business in connection with the  
 business, whether manufacturing or otherwise, and to have and exercise  
 all the powers conferred by the laws of South Carolina upon corporations  
 and under the act hereinafter referred to, and to do any or all the  
 things herebefore set forth to the same extent as natural persons might  
 do.

The objects and purposes specified in the foregoing clauses shall,  
 except where otherwise expressed, be in nowise limited or restricted by  
 reference to, or inference from, the terms of any other clause in this  
 Declaration for charter, but the objects and purposes specified in each each  
 of the foregoing clauses of this article shall be regarded as independent  
 objects and purposes.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Three Hundred Twenty-five Thousand / - - Dollars.  
 payable in money, or in labor or in property, at its par value, when and as required  
 by the Board of Directors.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is 3,250, of which 2,500 is Pre-  
 ferred stock and 750 is Common stock,  
 of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) - - - Dollars. each.

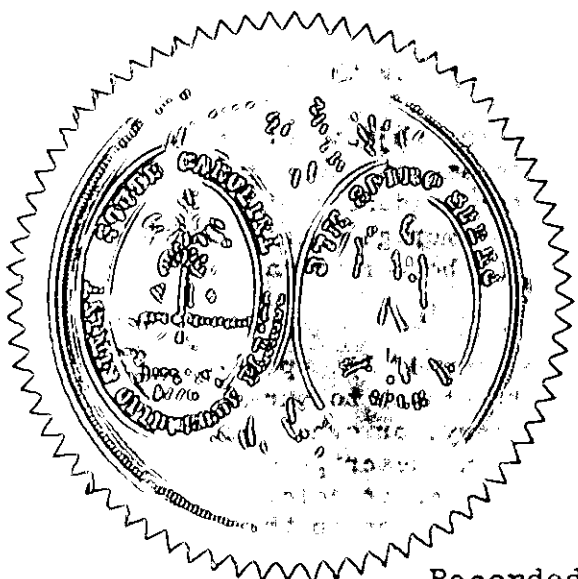
SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 31st day of  
 May, 1948, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the follow-  
 ing were elected directors: George A. Buckley, O. Ray Pine, Myer Roseman and  
 Wm. C. Torkington

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, George A. Buckley ;  
 as Vice-President Myer Roseman ; as Secretary, Wm. C. Torkington ;  
 as Treasurer, Wm. C. Torkington . as Asst. Secty.: O. Ray Pine  
 as Asst. Treas.: O. Ray Pine

NINTH: That all requirements of Article 2, Chapter 153, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1932, and all amendments  
 thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by  
*bona fide* subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice  
 of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Piedmont

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, W. P. BLACKWELL, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the afore-  
 said Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of  
 South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to  
 commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the  
 Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
