

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina and in the City of Greenville, on the eastern side of Woodland Way and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 58 and 59 according to plat of Cleveland Forest by Walton J. Hayes, Engineers, May 1940, and revised September 1945, and such plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Flat Book 1 at page 137, and having according to said revised plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Woodland Way at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 57 and 58 and running thence along the eastern side of Woodland Way N. 41-57 W. 60 ft. to an iron pin; thence continuing along the eastern side of Woodland Way N. 32-57 W. 65 ft. to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 58 and 59; thence continuing along the eastern side of Woodland Way N. 16-58 W. 47 ft. to an iron pin; thence continuing along the eastern side of Woodland Way N. 3-11 W. 38 ft. to an iron pin; thence following the curve of Woodland Way the chord of which is N. 46-15 E. 45.6 ft. to an iron pin on the southern side of Wilderness Lane; thence along the southern side of Wilderness Lane S. 34-20 E. 175 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 59-12 E. 27.3 ft. to an iron pin on an alley; thence along the western side of said alley S. 34-04 E. 85 ft. to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of lots Nos. 57 and 58; thence along the common line of the last-mentioned lots S. 58-34 E. 213.4 ft. to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
