All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville

of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, lying and being situate on the South side of Woodland Way, being known and designated as Lot #2, Dievoland Forest, according to Lat of Cleveland Forest, prepared by Dalton: Leves, Engineers, in May, 1940 as revised September, 1945, as recorded in the R. H. C. Office, Greenville, South Carolina, in Plat Look "L", on Page 137, and having according to said Plat, the following access and bounds, to-wit:

BAGINING at an iron pin on the South side of Woodland way at joint front corner of Lots #2 and #3, thence S. 31-22 E. 152.6 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots #2 and #3; thence S. 64-44 ... \$13 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 8-20 E. 160 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Woodland Way; thence continuing on an angle around the South side of woodland way, the chord of which is N. 55-03 E. 110 feet to an iron pin at joint front corner of Lots #2 and #3, the point of beginning.

The herein-named Granton is to pay the 1948 taxes on the above described property, up to this date.

The above described property is subject to restrictions recorded in the A. M. U. Office, Greenville, South Carolina, in Volume "K", on pages 47 and 90. Said property is further restricted in that no residential building costing less than \$10,000.00 may be built thereon, nor nearer than 50 feet to the Street line. Any residential building built on said bot shall face onto Woodland way.
