All of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being at the Northeast intersection of Virginia Avenue and Sumter Street, near the Town of Greer, in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 38 on plat of Development No. 2, Victor-Monaghan Company, Division of J.
