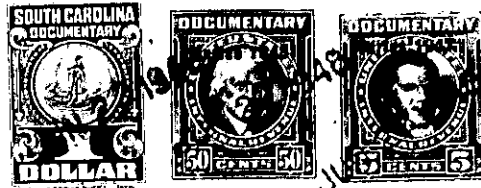

County, State of South Carolina, on the White Horse Road, about four miles from the Greenville County Court House and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at the most southernly corner of the land of A. W. Jones, the said corner being in the center of the White Horse Road and a joint corner between the lands of A. W. Jones and P. E. Freeman, and running thence northernly on said boundary N. 39-30 E. two hundred nineteen and two-tenths (219.2) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 84-30 W. 155 feet to a point in the center of said White Horse Road; thence 155 feet to the beginning corner, less a small strip taken by the Highway Department for highway purposes.
