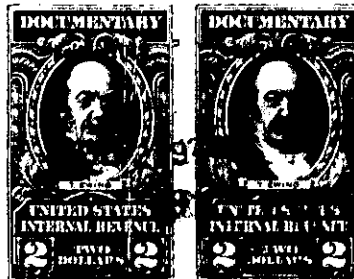

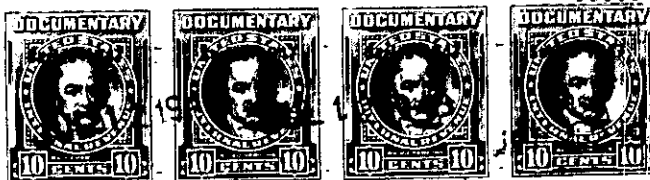
IN THE COUNTY COURT



To All Whom These Presents Shall Come:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Mrs. Linda Burns, et al



on or about the 22nd day of March in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-eight exhibited their
complaint in the County Court ~~of Greenville~~ for the County aforesaid, against
Thomas Burns, et al

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to
be heard on the 25th day of June, 1948,
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to B. H. Trammell
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$3750.00
HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said B. H. Trammell

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying
or being in Cleveland Township, County of Greenville and State of South
Carolina, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast bank of Gap Creek
and running thence up the mountain S. 36-45 E., 618 feet across large
slick rock on the face of the mountain to an iron pin and stone; thence
N. 62 E., 98 feet to an iron pin at oak; thence N. 50-30 E., 120 feet to
an iron pin; thence around the top ridge of mountain S. 83-30 E. 362
feet to an iron pin at oak; thence S. 53 E., 106 feet to an iron pin at
