Gilliam<sup>Jr.</sup> in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. E. Gilliam<sup>Jr.</sup> his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Paris Mountain Orchards Lot No. 8 as shown by Plat thereof made by G. A. Ellis dated January, 1947, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the intersection of Piney Mountain Road and Highway No. 253 and running thence with said Highway S. 48-10 W. 200 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 7; thence along the line of Lot No. 7 S. 100 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 9; thence along the line of Lot No. 9 N. 48-10 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on Piney Mountain Road; thence along said Road N. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
