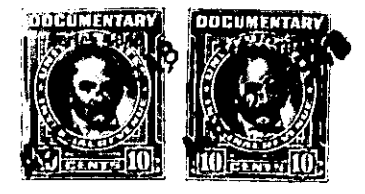

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in..... State..... Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina on the east side of the white horse road about
twelve miles northwest from the City of Greenville, and containing some
sixteen (16) acres, more or less, and adjoining lands with O'Neil and
Carrall on the north; lands with J. I. O'Sniels on the east; lands with
J. I. O'Sniels on the south and lands with McCauley on the west with the
white horse road intervening, and lands with McCauley on the northwest,
with the following lines and corners, to wit:

beginning at an iron pin on the white horse road (1/4 mile
north of the white horse road to O'Neil's line; thence thence said McCauley's line
to O'Neil's corner with this land, thence with O'Neil's line to Carrall's
corner; thence with Carrall's line to the north; thence to the south
