

J. Goodlett prepared by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, January 1922 (said plat being a revision of Lots 13, 14 and 15 of Block "J" and Lot #4 of Block "L" of Melrose Land Company) being recorded in the R. Being the identical property conveyed to the grantors by deed of Maurene Norton dated January 1, 1948, recorded in Deed Book 332 at page 4, said R. M. C. Office.
