in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Annie B. Finley

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situate about 2.5 miles from Greenville County House on the North side of the Finlay Bridge Road and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a stake 3X on back line 105 feet to a 30-foot street and running thence S. $9\frac{3}{4}$ West with line of Lot No. 6, 210 feet to a stake 3X on Finlay Bridge Road; thence along said road S. $80\frac{1}{4}$ East 105 feet to a stake 3X; thence N. $9\frac{3}{4}$ East 210 feet to a stake 3X on back line; thence with said line $80\frac{1}{4}$ West 105 feet to the beginning and being Lot No. 7 according to survey of J. N. Southern and being the same lot conveyed to J. H. Finley by Mary J. Cartledge on August 28th, 1924, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 96, at page 15.
