

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville which Greenville County. State of South Caroling known and designated as lot No. 94, on plat of Alta Vista, property of R. B. R. Land Development Company, said plat recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County, in Plat Book G, at page 20, and more particularly described as follows:
