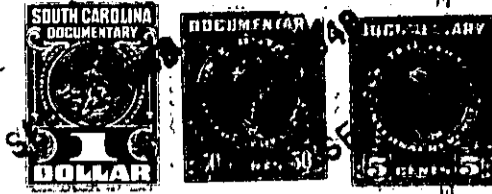

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, on the east side of a proposed street to be known as North Church Street Extension and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

beginning at an iron pin on the east side of said North Church Street Extension at the northwest corner of lot belonging to the City of Greenville and running thence along the east side of said street, N. 20-46 E. 100 feet to a bench in said street; thence still along the east side of said street, N. 34-10 E. 46.25 feet to iron pin; thence S. 0-43 W. 195.2 feet to an old store; thence S. 8-26 E. 62 feet, more or less, to iron pin; thence along the east side of lot belonging to the City of Greenville; thence along the west side of said lot, N. 62-16 W. 109.6 feet to the beginning
