Ezelle Gosnell his heirs and assigns, an undivided one-half interest in and to all that piece. parcel or tract of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the City of Greenville on the West side of West Washington Street and having, according to a Plat of the property of Elizabeth M. Gosnell by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, September, 1948, and to be recorded, the following metes and bounds to-wit: BEGIN ING at the Southwest intersection of West Washington Street and Forest Alley and running thence with West Washington Street N48-50W 60.1 feet to the outside corner of a brick wall; thence with the N. face of said wall S41-02 W 100 feet to an iron pin; thence S.48-50E 60 feet to an iron pin on Forest Alley; thence with Forest Alley N41-05E 100 feet to the point of beginning and being the same property conveyed to W. Austin Hudson and P. C. Poag by deed of R. E. Ernst dated September 9, 1919 and recorded in the R. M. C. Ofrice for Greenville County in Volume 55 at page 29.
