of South Carolina, and in the City of Greenville at the northwest corner of the intersection of Pendleton street and North Calhoun street, and being described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the northwest corner of Pendleton street and Calhoun street, and running thence along the line of Pendleton street in a westerly direction 91 feet, more or less, to a stake at the corner of lot now or formerly belonging to Bessie S.
