Talbert, in the State afore said, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and love and affection to us paid by George W. Griffin in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said George W. Griffin, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in the City of Greenville, on the Southeast side of Frank Street, and being known and designated as Lot No. 8 of the property of G. A. Norwood, as shown on plat thereof made by W. A. Hudson on July 8, 1908, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Frank Street at a point 150 feet Southwest of the intersection of Buncombe Street, and running thence S. 34-00 E. 179.5 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lots 4, 5 and 10; thence S. 56-00 W. 75 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 9; thence along the line of that lot, N. 34-00 W. 181 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Frank Street; thence along the line of Frank Street, N. 56-00 E. 75 feet to the beginning corner.
