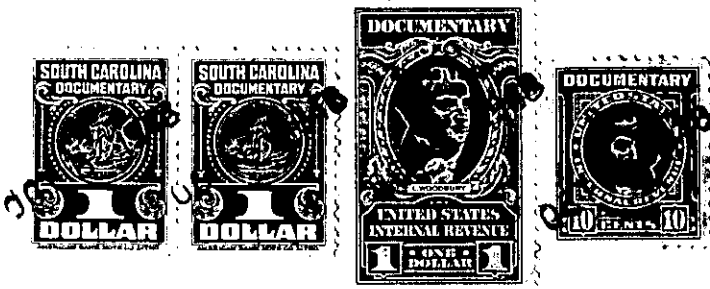

All our right, title and interest in and to
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, and in Town of Simpsonville, State of South
Carolina, being known and designated as Lot on which the parsonage
of the Simpsonville Circuit of the M. E. Church, South, stands,
