Beginning at an iron pin on the southeast side of Sixth Street at corner of Hamby property and running thence with line of Hamby property, S. $40\frac{1}{4}$ E. 1.62 chains to iron pin, corner of other property of Woodside Mills, known as the Baseball Park, and running thence with line of last mentioned property, N. $48\frac{1}{2}$ E. 1.36 chains to iron pin, corner of J. D. Bouchillon property; thence with line of last mentioned property, N. $40\frac{1}{4}$ W. 1.62 chains to iron pin on the southeast side of Sixth Street; thence along the southeast side of Sixth Street S. $48\frac{1}{4}$ W. 1.36 chains to the beginning corner.
