

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said\_\_STEEL\_HEDDLE\_MANUFACTURING\_CO\_\_\_\_ its Successors and Assigns, Forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, near Paris Station, being known and designated as Lots No. 3, 4 and 5 of the former property of Gladys Green Hack, said property being as shown on a plat entitled "Property of Gladys Green Hack" recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book R, at page 1, and being described according to a more recent plat prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service of Greenville, S. C., dated October 15, 1948, entitled "Property of Steel Heddle Manufacturing Co.", said property has according to said plat the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Paris School Road at the joint front corner of Lots No. 5 and 6, and running thence along the Southern side of said road, S. 52-45 E. 100 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots No. 4 and 5; thence continuing along the Southern side of said road, S. 50-19 E. 200 feet to an iron pin, the joint front corner of Lots No. 2 and 3; thence along the common line of said lots, S. 36-30 W. 708.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 39-15 W. 310.5 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots No. 5 and 6; thence along the common line of said last mentioned lots, N. 36-30 E. 644.3 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Paris School Road, the beginning corner.

This being the same property conveyed to the grantor herein by Gladys G. Hack by deed dated February 7, 1947, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Vol. 307, at page 34.

ALSO conveyed herein are all right, title and interest the grantor may have acquired in a proposed road running along the rear line of this property, which proposed road is shown on plats recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book B, at page 133, and Plat Book R, at page 1, and which proposed road was never opened.

Grantee assumes and agrees to pay 1948 State & County Taxes.

The property herein conveyed is shown on Plat Book B, at page 133 (R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C.) as Lots Nos. 3, 4 and 5 and 23, 24 and 25.
