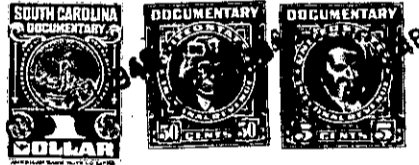

Jennings, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the South side of High Valley Boulevard, near the City of Greenville, in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot 49 on plat of Fresh Meadow Farms made by M. H. Woodward, May 21, 1945, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book M, page 127, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of High Valley Boulevard, at joint front corner of Lots 48 and 49, and running thence with the line of Lot 48 S. 8-37 W. 250 feet to iron pin; thence with the rear line of Lot 62 N. 81-23 W. 87 feet to iron pin at rear corner of Lots 49 and 50; thence with the line of Lot 50 N. 8-37 E. 250 feet to iron pin on the South side of High Valley Boulevard; thence along the South side of High Valley Boulevard S. 81-23 E. 87 feet to the beginning corner.
