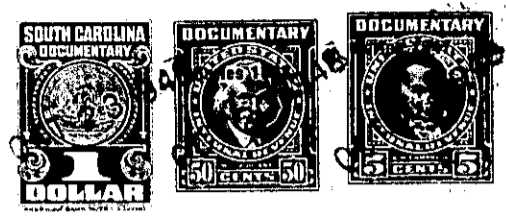

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. E. Sloan

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, near the southern limits of the town of Greer,
triangular in shape, described as follows:

BEGINNING At a pin on the west side of the Line street extension
about six hundred yards south of the intersection of said street
with the Woodruff road, corner of lands of J. R. Greene and W. E.
Sloan, and runs thence in a northwesterly direction 200 feet to a
point or pin in the center of a ditch; thence in a Southerly di-
rection with the center of said ditch 90 feet to a point or pin,
another corner of J. R. Greene and W. E. Sloan; thence in an easter-
