

their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on the Northeast side of Roper Mountain Road, about six miles East of the Greenville County Court House, in Butler Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 5.20 acres according to survey made by Dalton & Neves, December 1930, revised September 1948, and having according to said survey the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake in the center of Roper Mountain Road, at Southeast corner of property of Grantees herein, and running thence along line of other property of Grantees N. 48-30 E. 409 feet to iron pin; thence continuing along property of Grantees N. 34-28 W. 553.7 feet to iron pin; thence along line of other property of Grantor N. 48-30 E. crossing branch 293.9 feet to iron pin in line of property now or formerly of Hawkins; thence with said Hawkins line S. 27-40 E. 695.5 feet to stone in line of property now or formerly of Toy Vaughan; thence with said Vaughan line S. 48-30 W. 610 feet to stake in the center of Roper Mountain Road; thence with center of Roper Mountain Road N. 43-55 W. 125 feet to the beginning corner.

Being part of the property conveyed to me by Vera J. Hunter by deed dated September 28, 1946 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 299, at page 407.
