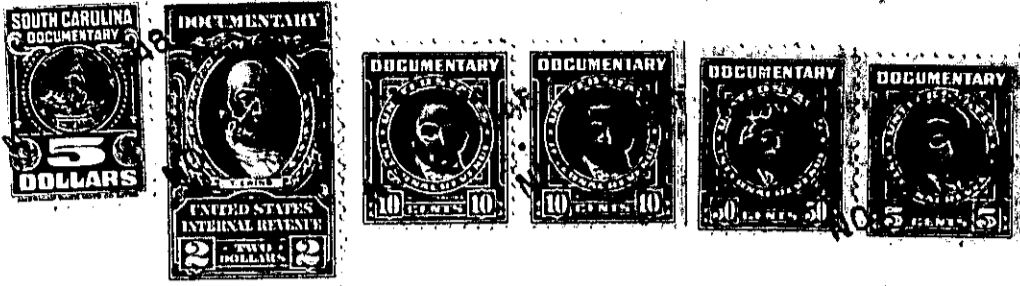

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of Gentry Street
at the corner of lot No. 32; thence in a northeasterly direction
with Gentry Street 50 feet to the corner of Lot No. 36; thence
in a northwesterly direction with line of Lot No. 36 150 feet
to the corner of lot No. 33; thence in a southwesterly direction
with lot No. 33, 50 feet to a stake at the corner of Lot No. 32;
thence in a southeasterly direction with Lot No 32, 150 feet to the
