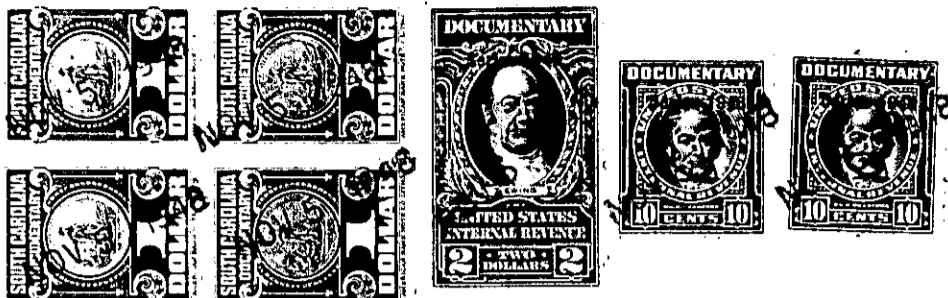

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said..... S. T. Cooper.....

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, located on the South side of public road  
leading off the Jonesville Road, Approximately 3 miles East from  
the Town of Simpsonville, S. C., adjoining lands of P. E. Hughes,  
and other lands of Grantor and having according to a plat and survey  
made by E. E. Gary, Surveyor, on Sept. 13, 1948 the following metes  
and bounds, To wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of the Road and running  
thence across the road and along line of P. E. Hughes, S. 1 3/4 W.  
34.25 chains to a point in Horse Pen Creek (Iron pin on bank);  
thence down the meanders of Horse Pen Creek, N. 51 1/2 E. 14.30 chains  
to point in creek; thence by an iron pin and on line of J. B. League,  
N. 2 3/4 W. 24.54 chains to iron pin on south side of Public road;  
thence across road N. 80 1/4 W. 6.42 chains to the beginning corner,  
and containing 26.67 acres more or less.
