Slater & Sons, Inc.) at Slater, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, said streets, avenues and roads being as shown on a plat of the "Village of S. Slater & Sons, Inc." made by J. E. Sirrine & Company, Engineers, on July 10, 1940, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at pages 63, 64 and 65.
