

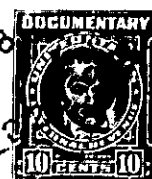

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said... William Dan Stepp and his  
heirs and assigns:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, lying on the North side of Cannon Avenue,  
in the Town of Greer, designated as Lot No. 25 on a plat of  
property of the M.T. Gaines Estate by H.S. Brockman, Surveyor,  
dated June 14, 1923, and having the following courses and distances,  
to wit: Beginning at the corner of Lot No. 24 on the North side
