Office for Greenville County, S.C. and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds to wit;

BEGINHING at a joint corner of lots Nos 1 and 2 on old pendleton Road. thence running S 27-20 W. 92.3 feet to an iron pin at the rear joint corner of said lots 1 and 2; thence running in a Westerdly direction 64.8 feet along the line of the Southern Rail Way property; thence N 27-20 E. 114.5 feet along the line of the P & N. The Charter of Honour Coal Company was concelled a number of years ago under Section 7704 of the 1942 Code of Laws of the State of South Carolina, and at the time of saidcancellation the sole officers and airectors were T. A. Honour and E. C. Honour. Since that time T. A. Honour has died and E. C. Honour is the sole surviving director 12Z-17-1
