

AND I HEREBY DECLARE THAT the powers and authority herein conferred upon said attorney shall continue in full force and effect until this Power of Attorney shall be revoked by an instrument in writing signed and acknowledged by me and filed for record in Mc Dowell County, State of North Carolina or until my death, whichever event should happen first. It is further understood and agreed that my death shall be sufficiently established to terminate this Power of Attorney upon the probating of my will or the appointment of an administrator of my estate. However, should I be reported as missing or missing in action or unaccounted for or a prisoner of war, then and in such events this Power of Attorney is to continue in full force and effect until it shall be revoked in writing as above provided or until my death has been established by the probating of my will or the appointment of an administrator of my estate, and the acts of my said attorney while I am reported missing, missing in action, unaccounted for or a prisoner of war, shall be binding upon me, my heirs, legatees, devisees and assigns even though it may subsequently be established that my death had actually occurred at or during the time I was reported as missing, missing in action, unaccounted for or a prisoner of war.
