SEPARATION AGREEMENT

of February, 1949 by and between Charles M. Denton, hereinafter called "husband", and Emma Louise Denton, hereinafter called "wife".

WITHESSETH:

WHEREAS, unhappy differences have arisen between said husband and wife which are deemed by said parties as being incapable of satisfactory adjustment,

NOW THEREFORE, said parties do mutually agree as follows:

- 1. That for and during the term of their natural lives said parties will at all times hereafter live separate and apart from each other as though unmarried, without any control, interference or restraint, direct or indirect with respect to each other's lives and activities.
- 2. That said husband has simultaneously with the signing of these presents paid over to said wife the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars and executed a deed representing a real property settlement which has been accepted by said wife, and who, by her signature hereto, acknowledges said payment and conveyance as representing a fair and reasonable division and property settlement, including all claims for support. In consideration of said payment and conveyance, said wife does hereby renounce any and all claims which she now has or may hereafter have to any and all property now, or at any time hereafter, standing in the name of said husband, or in their joint names, including all Dower rights.
- 3. Neither party shall contract debts in the name of the other, or in any way attempt to charge the other with any liability not herein specifically provided for.
