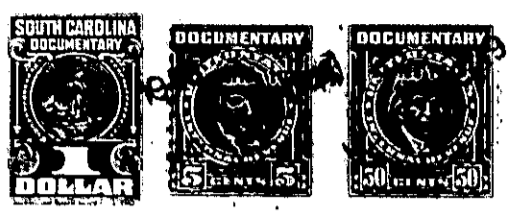

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, about one half mile west from Milford Baptist Church, lying on the northern side of the Milford-Double Springs Road (also known as the Mucklehany Road), being bounded on the north by other lands of myself, on the east by other lands of myself and lands of Homer Harbin, and on the south by the said road and lands of Homer Harbin, and being a part of the same land that was conveyed to me by deed from Mrs. Ella P. Groce (Mrs. T. M. Groce), and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

Beginning on a nail and stopper in the center of the said road, joint corner of the Homer Harbin lands, and runs thence with the said line N. 14-45 W. 133 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of the Harbin lands and other lands of myself, then continueing N. 14-45 W. for a total distance of 1044 feet to an iron pin, new corner; thence S. 86-45 W. 209.0 feet to an iron pin, new corner; thence S. 14-45 E. 1039 feet to a point in the center of the said Milford-Double Springs Road; thence with the center of the said road N. 87-35 E. 210 feet to the beginning corner, and containing Five (5) acres, more or less.
