All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in a subdivision known as Victor-Monaghan Co., Development No. 1, and being known and designated as Lots No. 28 and 29 of said subdivision. The property conveyed herein is described according to a plat entitled "Map of Victor-Monaghan Co., Development No. 1, near Greenville, S. C." prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, dated December, 1941, which plat is of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book M, at page 39. Said lots having, according to the aforementioned plat, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastern side of Forest Circle, at the joint front corner of Lots 27 and 28, and running thence along the Southeastern side of Forest Circle, a curved portion thereof, the chord of which runs N. 31-43 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the curve of the Southeastern side of Forest Circle, the chord of which runs N. 56-30 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, the joint front corner of Lots No. 28 and 29; thence continuing along the curve of said Forest Circle, the chord of which runs N. 84-45 E. 48 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the curve of Forest Circle, the chord of which runs S. 67-10 E. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence along Forest Circle, S. 51-30 E. 91.7 feet to an iron pin, the joint front corner of Lots 29 and 30; thence along the common line of said lots, S. 19-34 W. 195 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 77-20 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots No. 28 and 29; thence S. 45-43 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots No. 27 and 28; thence along the common line of said last mentioned lots, N. 44-17 W. 230.8 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
