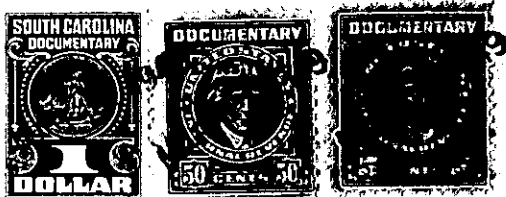

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The William Goldsmith Company,

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina

and having its principal place of business at

Greenville in the State of South Carolina

for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred and Fifty (\$450.00) Dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee.....  
hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and  
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Allen E. Vaughn.

All that piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being in City of  
Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the south side of Springer  
Street and being lots numbers 32, 33 and 34 together with a small strip  
off the western side of lots number 35 as shown on a plat thereof recorded  
in Plat Book A, Page 225, R. M. C. Office, Greenville County, and being a  
portion of the lands conveyed to the William Goldsmith Company by Wil-  
liam Goldsmith, Jr. by deed dated August 8, 1946, recorded in Deed Book 301,  
Page 46, R. M. C. Office, Greenville County. The lots covered by that  
deed have been recut and subdivided into three lots and <sup>the lot here conveyed</sup> is one of those  
three and is the western portion of the lands conveyed by that deed.  
It begins on the southern edge of Springer Street and runs thence along  
the southern edge of Springer Street N. 86 E. 150 feet to corner; thence  
approximately S. 2-30 W. 59 feet, more or less, to a branch; thence along  
the branch approximately N. 86 W. 150 feet to corner on property formerly  
referred to as the Thurston property; thence N. 2-30 E. 59 feet to the  
beginning corner.
