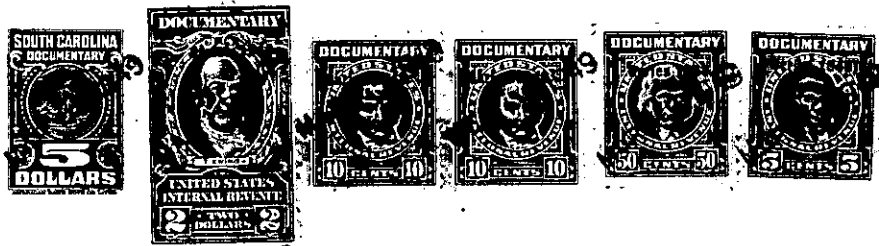
Know All Men by These Presents:
