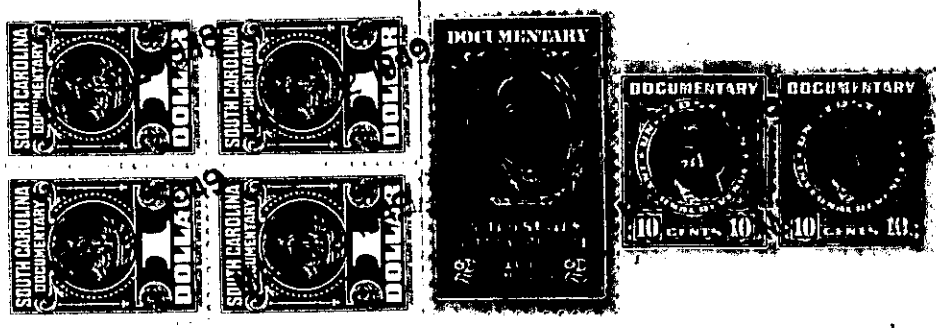

by FRANK R. STANTON and ALICE E. STANTON his wife.....
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FRANK R. STANTON and ALICE E. STANTON..

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in GREENVILLE Township, GREENVILLE
County, State of South Carolina known and designated as Lot #4, Block "C" of
the Melville Land Company subdivision as it appears by a plat
recorded in the Office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for
Greenville County in Plat Book A. at page 97 and having the
following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stake in the Southwestern Side of a
40 foot Street (Burdette Street), said stake being one
hundred and fifty (150) feet from the corner of Textile
Street and thence running South $43\frac{3}{4}$ West One Hundred and
fifty feet to a stake; thence North $46\frac{1}{2}$ West, fifty (50)
feet to a stake; thence North $43\frac{3}{4}$ East, One hundred and fifty
(150) feet to a stake in Burdette Street; thence with said
street South $46\frac{1}{2}$ East, fifty (50) feet to the beginning
stake.

Said Lot being part of the same property which was
conveyed to me by my husband, E. A. AIKEN, by a Deed the
20th. day of March, 1946 and recorded in Deed Book 289 at
Page 190.

Said Lot is now known as 38 Burdette Street, West
Greenville.
