Aiken, do hereby declare, and agree that I freely and voluntarily, and without any compulsion, dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever, to renounce, relinquish, and forever release all my right and claim of dower to any purchaser of any of the realestate now owned by my husband, and to any real estate which might here--after be acquired by my husband, and I further agree to sign away all my right and claim of dower in and to any and all of the real estate now owned, or which may hereafter be acquired by my busband.

I, Oder T. Weaver, the Party of the first part, do hereby agree as a further consideration for the foregoing promise of the part of Ruby C. Leaver, the party of the second part, do agree that I shall not, within the newt two years from the date of this agreement, file a suit for divorce against my wife in South Carolina or in any other State in the United States.
