

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Old Spartanburg Road joint corner of property formerly belonging to Eva S. Adams and Lot No. 5 in a subdivision of John R. Rodgers, and running along line of the Adams propertyN. I3-30 E. 52I.5 feet to iron pin on Adams line and the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 7 and 8; thence in an Easterly direction along lines of Lots Nos. 7 and 8, I44.9 feet to a stake; thence S. 5-55 E. I80 feet to joint corner of Lots Nos 2 and 3; thence running along the rear line of Lot No. 3, I00 feet to rear joint corner of Lots Nos. 3 and 4; thence S. 7-06 E. 293.6 feet to iron pin on Old Spartanburg Road, joint corner of Lots.
