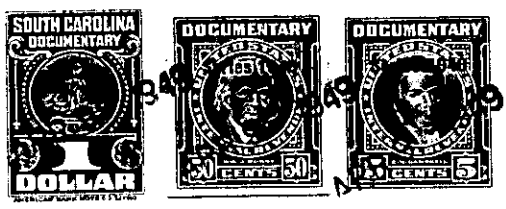

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said T. C. Hawthorne

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, Westville School District in a colored community
known as Freetown and as shown by a subdivision represented by a plat
prepared by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, March, 1949, and on the West
side of Church Street, designated as Lot No. 3 on said plat and
having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the south side of Church Street, common
corners of Lots Nos. 3 and 2, which stake is 133 feet from the south-
west intersection of Church Street and Arnod Street and running thence
with the boundary line of Lots Nos. 2 and 3, S. 81-02 W. 131.3 feet
to a stake, the same being rear corners of Lots 2 and 3; thence
S. 14-03 E. 39 feet to a stake, the rear corners of Lots 3 and 4;
thence N. 85-47 E. 132.4 feet to a stake on the west side of Church
Street, common corners of Lots 3 and 4; thence along the property
line on Church Street, N. 13-13 W. 50 feet to the point and place
of the beginning, and designated as Lot No. 3 on said plat, reference
