


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That...L. L. A. Massey,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of...Twenty-two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$2,250.00)....Dollars to me.....in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by James W. Barr and Nina W. Barr.....(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James W. Barr and Nina W. Barr, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being on the Southeast side of the Jersey Road, in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, S. C., being known as Lots 12 and 13 on plat of Hillandale Estates made by Madison H. Woodward, Surveyor, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book B, page 145, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of the Jersey Road at joint front corner of Lots 13 and 14, and running thence with the line of Lot 14, S. 38-30 E. 535 feet to an iron pin in creek; thence with creek, N. 51-30 E. 159 feet to a point in creek; thence N. 29-45 W. 568 feet to a stone on the Southeast edge of the Jersey Road; thence along the Southeast edge of Jersey Road, S. 70-58 W. 246 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of that property conveyed to me by deed of Allen F. Johnson dated January 25, 1943, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 114, page 30. The title to this property is subject to the restrictive covenants applicable to Hillandale Estates recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 373, page 319.

The grantees are to pay 1949 taxes.
