

M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, at page 257, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit: -

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Cumberland Avenue at the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 16 and 17, said pin being 300 feet from the intersection of Cumberland Avenue with Hanover Street, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 58-40 E. 150 feet to a pin at the joint rear corners of Lots Nos. 6 and 7; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 7, S. 31-20 W. 50 feet to a pin at the joint rear corners of Lots Nos. 7 and 8; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 15 and 16, N/58-40 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Cumberland Avenue; thence along the Southeast side of Cumberland Avenue N. 31-20 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
