Haynesworth, Jr. as Trustee by deed recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County, S. C. in Vol. 297, Page 355, dated August 19, 1946, and conveyed by said Mitchell F. Mote and Nolie Mote to the above named grantor by deed dated May 17, 1949 not yet recorded and having the following metes and bounds:
