

All of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the South side of Louise Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lot No. 50 on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M, at page 39, and having, according to said plit, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots No. 59 and 60, and running thence along the common line of said lots, S. 16-10 L. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 73-50 W. 60.3 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Monaghan Avenue; thence slong Tonaghan Avenue, N. 49-0 W. 178 feet to an iron pin; thence along the curve of Monaghan Avenue, the chord of which runs W. 18-14 W. 31 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the curve of Tonaghan Avenue as it converges with Louise Avenue, the chord of which curve is N. 45-23 E. 34 feet to an iron pin; theme along the South side of Louise Avenue, N. 73-50 E. 133 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
