to ..... me ..... in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mae P. Willis, her heirs, executors, assigns,  
forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and  
improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Northwest side  
of Brockman Avenue (sometimes known as Darlington Avenue) near the  
City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina,  
being known as Lot No. 29, on plat of Property of Etzel Y. Perry  
Estate, made by W. J. Riddle, surveyor, September 1944, recorded in  
the R. I. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in the book 3,  
page 33, and having according to said plat, the following lines and  
bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Brockman Avenue,  
at joint front corner of lots 28 and 30, setting out 3 feet  
in a northeasterly direction from the point where the Northwest side  
of Brockman Avenue intersects with the Northeast side of Belvoir  
Avenue and running thence along the line of Lot 30, N. 53-30 W. 177.1  
feet to an iron pin on the east side of Belvoir Avenue; thence along  
the east side of Belvoir Avenue, N. 51-11 W. 17.4 feet to an iron pin;  
thence N. 88-08 E. 58.3 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of  
Lot 28, S. 30-30 E. 177.2 feet to an iron pin on the Northwest side  
of Brockman Avenue; thence with the Northwest side of Brockman Avenue,  
S. 53-30 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.

The Grantee assumes and agrees to pay that mortgagel by James L. Willis to C. Douglas Wilson & Co. dated April 18, 1941, in the original amount of \$6,850.00, recorded in the R. I. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Mortgage Book 386, page 476; and the Grantee also assumes and agrees to pay that mortgagel by James L. Willis to E. R. Griffin dated April 5, 1940 in the original amount of \$500.00, recorded in the R. I. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Mortgage Book 386, page 242.

The Grantee is to pay 1943 taxes.
