- Page Three -

other than the Trustee, and including any legal expenses incurred by the Trustee, to pay over the net proceeds to the payment of the mortgage liens on the property in the order of their priority upon the property from which the proceeds are realized, and to hold any surplus for the payment of any deficiency arising from the sale of other property and in the event the proceeds from any property is insufficient to pay the mortgage debt, any deficiency shall be paid from the surplus arising from the sale of other property.

- 5. After payment of all of the expenses of administration and all mortgage liens to pay over the balance to the grantor, its successors or assigns.
- 6. The Trustee by the acceptance of this deed incurs no liability other than to account for such monies as are actually received by him.
