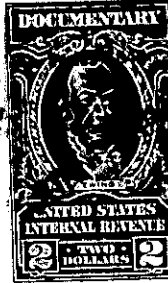

burg Road, near lake formerly known as Howell's Lake, and accord-
ing to survey made by G. A. Ellis, Surveyor, April 1946 has the
following courses and distances, to wit:-

Beginning on an iron pin on Old Spartanburg Road, corner of
property conveyed to Earl M. Dill, and runs thence S. 39-00 E.
1100 feet along the eastern line of the said Dill property to
an iron pin in line of Gibson property; thence due north 240
feet to a cement shoulder on the Gibson line; thence N. 30-00W.
875 feet along the Black line to an iron pin on the Old Spartan-
burg Road; thence S. 64-00 W. 263 feet along the Old Spartanburg
Road to the beginning corner, containing Four and Sixty Five (4.65)
acres, more or less.
